The sales for the jumpers have officially started. So, get yours until the 13th of January, using the following link: <https://cdewix.wixsite.com/cdeweb/shop>

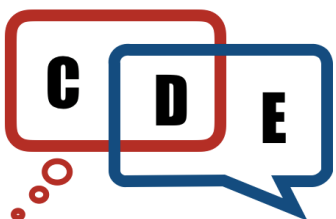
### What does the CDE do for the wellbeing of the students?
